Learning Opportunities Available:

- In person:
 - Attendance is expected, daily
 - There are consequences for lack of attendance and tardies
 - Count Days and State testing are mandatory

Online:

- Considered on a case by case basis
- Requirements:
 - Documentation from a certified professional
 - Permission from the Principal
 - Weekly check in with counselor
 - Count Days' activities and State testing (in person) are mandatory
 - Online participation is subject to change if a student is not checking in weekly and earning credits

Attendance/Tardies: General Policy

- More than 5 absences in one term will result in the student being paused for the remainder of the term (online may be considered as a possibility)
- The number of minutes for tardies will be tracked by teachers and may count as a day of absence
 - Hours 1 and 3: 90 minutes will result in an absence and count towards the 5
 - Hour 2: 50 minutes will result in an absence and count towards the 5
- Excused and Unexcused absences are considered in our attendance policy
 - It is still strongly recommended that any absence is reported

 - Documentation will be expected
 - Excused Absences Include:
 - Personal or family illnesses/emergencies
 - Pre-arranged medical/dental appointments that cannot be scheduled outside school hours
 - Religious holidays
 - Funerals
 - Legal appearances
 - Legitimate business purposes
 - Absences for unauthorized reasons or unconfirmed by parent/guardian communication will be considered unexcused.
 - Any student who enters/leaves the school building without properly signing in/out will not receive excused absences and may be assigned disciplinary consequences.
- When you are absent or tardy you should plan to stay in the afternoon in order to catch up on the work you missed
- Staying in the afternoon for academic probation, assigned by the teacher, may excuse or lessen your tardies or absence counts at teachers discretion.
- If you do not start the term on time, it will be an expectation that you stay in the afternoon(s) for the number of days you start late

Change of Placement/Dropping Students:

- Students that are paused from learning may result in them being dropped from the program or a change of placement to Continuing Education
- A meeting with the principal may be required prior to returning the next term if you have been paused
 - A parent/guardian must attend for students under 18

Email and Communication:

- Email and in person announcements are the primary form of communication
- Students are expected to check their email daily to keep informed, failure to do so will not be an acceptable excuse
- Parent/Guardian emails that are entered into MiStar will also receive the information

Grading:

- Students will receive letter grades based on their completed work, projects and assessments*.
 - *Please note: some teachers/courses require in person or monitored online assessments (tests, quizzes, final)

On-line Class:

- All students will take an online class each term
- Online classes may need to be worked on outside of school hours
- See Below for more information regarding online classes

Art/World Language Classes:

- Art and World Language classes are held through the Continuing Education program
- Classes are held in the late afternoon/evening between the hours of 4-8
- These are in addition to the 3 scheduled during the school day

Adding Additional Classes within a Term:

- Students do have the option of adding an additional class during a term as long as they are in good standing in other classes and with attendance.
- Adding a class may occur when a student has completed one of their three originally assigned classes
 in a term and it is determined there is still time to finish the class by the end of the term.
